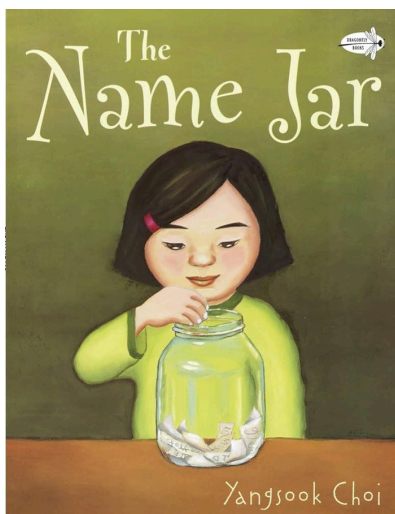
FSLW UPDATE
